Cem Duruöz (or "Gem" as pronounced in his native tongue) won the first prize in the Turkish National Guitar Competition at the age of seventeen. He has recently performed in Brazil, Peru, France, Serbia-Montenegro, Spain, Greece, Poland, Mexico, throughout Turkey and the USA, and has given his New York debut recital at the Carnegie Hall. He has also appeared as soloist with various orchestras and has released three CDs under Centaur and Karınca labels to international critical acclaim. An alumnus of the Juilliard School, Cem Duruöz has been conducting master-classes throughout the world, running a guitar summer school at the Akdeniz University Conservatory in Turkey and teaching guitar performance at Wesleyan University in Connecticut. James Baird, a resident of Milford, received his degree from Mannes College of Music under the tutelage of Frederic Hand. James formed the soprano and classical guitar duo of Bartos and Baird which performed extensively throughout Latin America and New England, also giving master classes. James later formed the widely acclaimed flute/guitar duo of Windwood that appeared throughout the region, including the Shubert Theatre in New Haven. Currently, Mr Baird performs as solo guitarist and with Baird/Wyton Flute & Guitar Duo. He contributes actively to the classical guitar repertoire, publishing transcriptions for solo guitar and chamber music for guitar. Mr. Baird teaches in public schools. Guitar Summer Workshop 2010

A 2-week guitar workshop will be held this summer during the month of **August** at the Milford Fine Arts Council's **Center for the Arts**, 40 Railroad Avenue South, Milford, CT. The workshop runs for 2 weeks, 4 days a week, culminating in a student recital for friends and family.

Classes are divided into age two groups for 9-12 years old and 12-18+ years old. Approximately 10 students will be allowed per class. Instructors for the Guitar Summer Workshop are the internationally acclaimed performers/ instructors **Cem Duruöz** and **James Baird**.

The program covers **Fundamentals of Guitar Playing, Learning to read Musical Notation, and Group Performance Skills with Musical Games**. Guitar instruction illustrates fundamental right and left hand techniques for finger-style guitar playing as applied to the classical guitar. Music notation covers the basic components of music: rhythm, melody and harmony, as well as reading music as applied to the guitar fingerboard. Instruction will benefit aspiring guitarists with little or no experience, regardless of musical background or preference.

Structure: Fundamentals of Guitar Playing, Music Ensemble Performance and Reading Music Notation
